

जल संरक्षण

जल - चक्र क्या है?

जल की एक मुख्य विशेषता यह है की यह अपनी अवस्था आपसो में बदल सकता है। यह ठोस पर अपनी तीन अवस्थाओं, ठोस, द्रव तथा गैस के रूप में आपसो में जात हो जाता है। पृथ्वी पर जल की मात्रा निश्चित है। जल का चक्र अपनी स्थिति बदलते हुए चलता रहता है जिसे हम जल चक्र अथवा जल-चक्रण चक्र कहते हैं। जलचक्र चक्र की प्रक्रिया जलमंडल, एक से दूसरे क्षेत्र में जहाँ वातावरण तथा पृथ्वी की सतह का प्रभाव मौजूद होता है। इस जलमंडल में जल की गति ही जल चक्र कहलाता है। यह संपूर्ण प्रक्रिया बहुत ही सरल है जिसे चित्र में 6 भागों में विभाजित किया गया है।

जल चक्र पृथ्वी पर उपलब्ध जल के एक रूप से दूसरे में परिवर्तित होने और एक भण्डार से दूसरे भण्डार या एक स्थान से दूसरे स्थान को गति करने की रासायनिक प्रक्रिया है जिसमें कुल जल की मात्रा का ह्रास नहीं होता। इस रूप परिवर्तन और स्थान परिवर्तन होता है। अतः यह प्रकृति में जल संरक्षण के सिद्धांत की व्याख्या है।

जलीय परिसंचन (circulation) द्वारा निर्मित एक चक्र जिनके अंतर्गत जल महासागर से वाष्पमंडल में वाष्पमंडल से भूमि (भारत) पर और फिर वाष्प महासागर में प्रदूष जाता है। महासागर से वाष्पीकरण द्वारा जलवाष्प के रूप में जल वाष्पमंडल में ऊपर उठता है जहाँ अत्यधिक सतह पर जल वाष्पमंडल में जल वाष्प (precipitation) द्वारा खनवर्ण वाष्पमंडल से जल वाष्पमंडल में उतरता है और फिर जल वाष्पमंडल से जल वाष्पमंडल में उतरता है। इस प्रकार जल चक्र पर हो जाता है।

जल चक्र

सागर से वाष्पमंडल तथा धरत पर से होता हुआ वाष्प सागर तक जाने वाला जल का परिसंचरण नहीं। जल वाष्प सागर तक धरत पर से बहता हुआ अथवा भूमिगत मार्गों से पहुंचता है। इस निरंतर चलते रहने वाले चक्र में जल अस्थायी रूप से भंडारों के रूप में जमा होता रहता है।

इसके मुख्य चक्र में सर्वाधिक उपयोग में लाए जाने वाला जल रूप - पानी (द्रव) है जो वाष्प बनकर वाष्पमंडल में जाता है फिर संचयित होकर बादल बनता है और फिर बादल बनकर ठोस (हिमपात) या द्रव रूप में वर्षा के रूप में बरसता है। हिम पिघलकर पुनः द्रव में परिवर्तित हो जाता है। इस तरह जल की कुल मात्रा स्थिर रहती है।

यह पृथ्वी के संपूर्ण पर्यावरण रूपी पारिस्थितिक तंत्र में एक भूजैवरासायनिक चक्र (Geobiochemical cycle) का उदाहरण है। चिन सजीव पदार्थों का एक पूर्ण चक्र जिसमें होकर पानी, वाष्पमंडलीय जलवाष्प के रूप में आता है। होकर द्रव्य या ठोस रूप में बरसता है और अत्यधिक मात्रा में वाष्प के ऊपर आने तक भीतर बहने लगता है एवं जलवाष्प वाष्प तथा वाष्पमंडल द्वारा पुनः वाष्पमंडलीय जलवाष्प के रूप में बन जाता है।






